# FALL BULKY TRASH DAY October 11, 2008



Southampton Township will hold its' semi-annual bulky trash day on Saturday, October 11th, from 7:00am until 3:00pm. Township households can once again take advantage of this opportunity to get

rid of any junk that they have collected over the year(s) that they cannot put into their regular trash. The drop off spot will be at the township building on Municipal Drive. Drive *behind* the township facility where someone will greet you. We will get your name and address and answer any questions you have about disposal of your junk. There are certain items that we cannot take and others that we have to charge a minimal fee.

## Items that we cannot accept at junk day are:

- Liquid wastes of any kind including waste oil, paint, insecticides, inks, solvents
- Aerosols or pressurized containers
- Motors containing gasoline or oil
- Tanks-welding or cooking
- Ammunition or anything explosive
- Dead animals
- No. 55 gallon drums
- Hospital/biolhazard waste, industrial wastes or any kind
- Anything containing asbestos
- No contaminated soil or yard waste
- Computer monitors cannot be accepted

Of course, the township must reserve the right to refuse anything that it thinks it is a hazard. The township will take up to 4 automobile tires from each household 15" or smaller free of charge. We do not accept tires with rims on. There will be a fee charged for any more than 4 tires or any tires larger than 15".

Refrigerators, air conditioners or anything that has Freon in will also have a \$5.00

charge.

The township can accept automobile batteries in small numbers. We will have big roll-off containers on site. If you are able bodied, you will be directed to a self unload zone to help keep things moving. If you need help we will direct you to an area where we will be happy to help you.

As a free service to assist elderly, handicapped, and those who have no other means to transport bulky items, or just need special help, a group of volunteers directed by township resident Lane Thrush and the gang from Point of Difference Team @ RE/ MAX Realty Agency will pick up the items for you on Friday, October 10. You will still be responsible for any fees that may be associated with the junk. If you need help and want to schedule a pickup, just call Renee at Remax at 709-7063 by Wednesday, October 8th to schedule their help.

### SPRING BULKY TRASH DAY REPORT

Southampton Township saw 295 different residents who brought 390 loads of trash! There was 88,340 pounds of trash hauled to the landfill. In addition, there were 226 tires recycled and several trailers of metal recycled.

Please be sure to have your leaves raked as close to the road as possible. Leaves too far off of the road will not be collected. Leaf collection generally ends after the first snowfall.
