# FALL BULKY TRASH DAYS OCTOBER 8TH AND 9TH, 2010

Southampton Township will hold its semiannual bulky trash days on Friday, October 8th, from 12:00 noon until 5:00pm, and on Saturday, October 9th, from 7:00am until 2:00pm. Township households can once again take advantage of this opportunity to get rid of any junk that they have collected over the year(s) that they cannot put into their regular trash. The drop off spot will be at the



township building on Municipal Drive. Drive behind the township facility where someone will greet you. We will get your name and address and answer any questions you have about disposal of your junk. There

are certain items that we cannot take and others that we have to charge a minimal fee.

Items that we cannot accept are: liquid wastes of any kind, including waste oil, paint, insecticides, inks and solvents, aerosols or pressurized containers. No motors containing gasoline or oil, tanks-welding or cooking; ammunition or anything explosive. No 55-gallon drums, hospital/ biohazard waste, industrial wastes of any kind, or anything containing asbestos. No contaminated soil or yard waste, or dead animals. Of course, the township must reserve the right to refuse anything that it thinks is a hazard.

The township will take up to 4 automobile tires from each household 15" or smaller free of charge. We do not accept tires on rims. There will be a fee charged for any more than 4 tires or any tires larger than 15".

Refrigerators, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, or anything that has Freon in will also have a \$5.00 charge. Computer monitors will now have a \$5.00 charge.

The township can accept automobile batteries in small numbers.

We will have big roll-off containers on site. If you are able bodied, you will be directed to a self-

unload zone to help keep things moving. If you need help we will direct you to an area where we will be happy to help you.

As a free service to assist elderly, handicapped, and those who have no other means to transport bulky items, or those who just need special help, township resident, Lane Thrush of RE/MAX Realty Agency in Chambersburg is offering volunteers to pick up the items for you on Friday, October 8th. You will still be responsible for any fees that may be associated with the junk. If you need help and want to schedule a pickup, just call Lane's office at 709-7070 by Wednesday, October 6th.

Please keep our township clean of junk by getting rid of it properly.

The Computer Barn will be at Bulky Trash Days taking ALL your old computer components to recycle. This would include all monitors, computers, key-



boards, printers, fax machines, DVD/VHS players, stereos, and even all of your old wiring to be recycled. Please note, there will be a be \$5.00 charge for computer monitors.

# LEAF COLLECTION SCHEDULE

Dates are approximate

Begins: October 18th Ends: November 24th

Leaf collection will run Mondays through Thursdays. Collection will begin on the following Monday where it left off the previous week. With more than 60 miles of roads, it may not be possible for your leaves to be collected every week.

Things that help to improve our collection efficiency are to have the leaves along the roadway. Leaves that cannot be reached with the hose, will not be collected. Keep leaves raked *away* from mailboxes, telephone poles, trees and out from under shrubs.

Unless absolutely necessary, it is preferable that your leaves not be collected into trash bags and left by the roadside. Proper return/disposal of the bags is time consuming and trash bags are frequently passed by assuming they are garbage.

# Septic System Pumping Reminder ZONE-2

If you have an on-lot septic system and live in Zone 2 on the map, you probably have received a letter reminding you to have your system pumped. Please be sure to contact one of the township licensed pumper/haulers to have this done by December 31, 2010 to avoid further action!



#### A NOTE FROM THE ROADMASTER

Pennsylvania's Second Class Township Code stipulates that all brush and refuse must be kept out of the road right-of-way. The township has the right to clear out brush along the sides of the road that interferes with public travel. All clearing and removal of the brush shall be confined to the growth that is within the right-of-way.

No tree with a diameter greater than six inches will be removed without first giving notice to the property owner.
