These signs are highly reflective and very visible. It will be easier for emergency services, visiting friends, family, and repair and delivery persons to find your home, especially at night. In addition, it looks great and is inexpensive.

Reflective address markers offer these benefits:

- Better visibility. Especially at night, when reflected by headlights and when it counts the most. Help 911, fire, and law enforcement find your home quickly.
- Low cost and peace of mind. An inexpensive way to help ensure home safety and security.

Do I really need one of these address signs? My house already has numbers on it.

To find out, drive or walk up and down the street in front of your house. Put yourself in the position of a rescuer that's racing to your house in a life or death situation. Can your address be seen clearly and easily from the street, at a distance, and especially at night? Statistics indicate that Emergency Services receive millions of phone calls per year for emergencies and accidents that occur at home. Rescue personnel will tell you that finding the home is the hardest part. Wasted minutes and seconds can mean all the difference. If you have numbers that can't be seen or are small, peeling, falling off, faded, etc. then the answer is YES, I need a new address sign.



Help yourself and your community by making sure your home can be found easily and quickly. At the very least, your pizza will always be hot! West End Fire and Rescue are providing at cost the 6" X 18" reflective aluminum sign with green background that will clearly display your street address. Each sign has your street address prominently displayed on both sides of the sign, in highly reflective 3" numbers against a green background similar to those on an interstate sign. The signs are installed in such a way that insures their visibility, even in high grass and snowy weather conditions.

LEAF COLLECTION SCHEDULE

Begins: **End of October**

Ends: **November 27th**

Leaf collection will run Mondays through Thursdays. Collection will begin on the following Monday where it left off the previous week. With more than 60 miles of roads, and inclement weather, it may not be possible for your leaves to be collected every week.

- Leaves must be raked into a row running parallel with the road.
- Leaves must be raked away from mailboxes, poles, cars and other obstructions.
- Twigs and branches must be kept out of leaf piles as they clog the machine
- Be careful not to rake up stones, they are hard on the leaf machine.
- Leaves must not be raked within 50 ft. of a stop sign, this creates a dangerous situation.

Unless absolutely necessary, it is preferable that your leaves not be collected into trash bags and left by the roadside. Proper return/disposal of the bags is time consuming and trash bags are frequently passed by assuming they are garbage.

If your leaves are not being collected, it may be because one of the above items are not being followed.


