Electronics Recycling Center Cumberland County

Washington Township has unfortunately closed their electronic collection to other township's residents. With the entire county taking them electronics, they could no longer afford the extra manpower dedicated to manage the facility.

A new alternative for Southampton Township residents is to take advantage of Cumberland County's Electronic Recycling Center. This service is open to anyone regardless of place of residence. Cumberland County charges customers \$.50 per pound. The fee will offset the County's costs for collecting, packaging, loading, shipping and recycling electronics and does not generate a profit. Customers will NOT be able to recycle electronics for free. Acceptable materials include:

- Televisions
- Computers & Accessories
- Mobile Devices
- Entertainment Equipment
- Office Equipment
- Data Center Equipment
- Cable Equipment



ONLY WHOLE, INTACT TVS
WILL BE ACCEPTED .

LEAF COLLECTION SCHEDULE

Begins: **End of October**

Ends Approximately: **November 21st**



Once leaf collection begins, it will run Mondays through Thursdays. Collection will begin on the following Monday where it left off the previous week. With more than 60 miles of roads, and inclement weather, it may not be possible for your leaves to be collected every week.

- Leaves **must** be raked into a row next to the black-top.
- Leaves must be raked away from mailboxes, poles, cars and other obstructions.
- Twigs and branches must be kept out of leaf piles as they clog the machine.
- Be careful not to rake up stones, they are hard on the leaf machine.
- Absolutely NO pet waste!
- Leaves must not be raked within 50 ft. of a stop sign, this creates a dangerous situation.

Unless absolutely necessary, it is preferable that your leaves not be collected into trash bags and left by the roadside. Proper return/disposal of the bags is time consuming and trash bags are frequently passed by assuming they are garbage.

If your leaves are not being collected, it may be because one of the above items are not being followed.
