

Winter Weather Advisory

After the wet summer that we have been dealing with it's hard to predict what winter has in store, but there are a few things that can be done to make dealing with the snow a little easier.

- When following a snowplow, please remain at a safe distance behind the vehicle so that the operator can see you. These trucks stop and back up often as well as deposit anti-skid on the road surface.
- Check your mailbox to make sure it is ready for winter. Snow is very heavy when coming off the plow. The force of the snow hitting your mailbox can easily damage the mailbox if not secured properly. Over time, posts can decompose or screws and bolts become loose. Spend a few minutes now to repair your mailbox instead of doing it this winter when it is cold and snow is on the ground. If your mailbox is located within the limits of the legal right-of-way, any damages caused by snow or ice are the responsibility of the property owner.
- You may want to consider the use of reflective tape or other material to make your mail-box easier to see during storms or during dark hours. The use of reflective flexi-posts around the edge of your yard can help guide snowplows keeping them off of the grass.
- When clearing snow from your driveway clear an area to the right of your driveway (see diagram), this will allow the snow to "unload" from the plow before reaching your driveway. This will help minimize the amount of snow you get in the bottom of your driveway after you finish clearing it.

Recommendation for Driveway Snow Removal



- When clearing your driveway, do not shovel or blow the snow onto the road. This creates a dangerous icy patch on the road that is very difficult to remove.
- Please keep items off the roadway. Basketball hoops are not meant to be on the roadway. If a plow truck encounters a basketball hoop, they will need to go around which does not allow them to remove the snow, cinder or salt the roadway. This could result in icy situations later. Also, be sure to remove all trash cans as soon as possible. The Township is not responsible for damage to items within the road right-of-way.
- During snow events, please do not park on Township roads or in cul-de-sacs. Snow is very heavy when being pushed by a plow. If your car is parked on the road it is possible for snow or other debris being moved by the plow to damage your vehicle.



Christmas Tree Disposal

Beginning December 26th, Christmas trees can be taken to the Township building for disposal. During working hours (7am to 4pm) Christmas trees can be placed inside the fence to the left when you pull into the maintenance building driveway. If after hours, please gently toss over the fence onto the pile. There will be signs to guide you. You may dispose of your Christmas trees through the middle of January.

The Christmas trees are taken to the Borough of Shippensburg's Recycling Facility to be recycled into mulch. Southampton Township

Composting Options for Township Residents

Township Residents can take advantage of the Borough of Shippensburg's Recycling Facility throughout the year. A one-year pass-card may be purchased for \$22 from the Borough Office located at 111 N. Fayette Street. The cards run annually from January 1st through December 31st.

Christmas trees, leaves, shrubbery, clippings, brush, garden and yard waste is acceptable. No grass clippings, garbage, dirt, stones or fruits will be accepted.

Residents may also purchase compost and mulch.

Southampton Township will hold its semi-annual bulky trash days on Friday, October 12th, from 12:00pm until 5:00pm, and on Saturday, October 13th, from 7:00am until 12:00pm. The drop off spot will be at the township building on Municipal Drive. There are certain items that we cannot take and others that we require a minimal fee.

Items we DO NOT ACCEPT:

- liquid wastes of any kind, including waste oil, paint, insecticides, inks and solvents, aerosols or pressurized containers
- motors containing gasoline
- ammunition or anything explosive
- hospital/biohazard waste
- industrial wastes of any kind
- anything containing asbestos
- yard waste or soil
- ♦ dead animals
- tires on rims

♦ NO ELECTRONICS WILL BE ACCEPTED

The Township will accept up to 4 automobile tires from each household 15" or smaller free of charge. There will be a \$3/tire charge for each additional tire, and a \$4 charge for 16"-19" residential/light duty tires. No heavy duty/commercial truck or tractor tires will be accepted.

Refrigerators, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, or anything that has freon in will have a \$5.00 charge. We accept microwaves at no charge.

The township can accept automobile batteries in small numbers.

We will have big roll-off containers on site if you would like to self-unload. Otherwise, the employees will be happy to help you unload into the loaders.

If you self-unload, we will have **metal salvage** trailers on-site. Please take a few extra minutes to throw all metal items into these trailers for recycling.

* TIP: If you have paint cans with a small amount of wet paint in, open the cans now and put some kitty litter in. This will absorb the liquid and get hard. We can accept them at this point.

As a free service to assist **elderly** and **handicapped**, Lane Thrush of Keller-Williams Keystone Realty in Chambersburg is offering volunteers to pick up the items for you on Thursday, October 11th. You will still be responsible for any fees that may be associated with the junk. If you need help and want to schedule a pickup, just call Lane's office at 717-504-8002 no later than Wednesday, October 10th.

Leaf Collection Trivia

Each load of leaves collected weighs approximately 3,000 lbs. During peak leaf collection, the Township can collect up to 10 loads a day! The amount of loads are counted for county recycling reports each year. The amount of loads collected can vary greatly from one year to the next. All leaves collected are recycled, either to Township farmers or residents for mulch, livestock bedding or they are composted at the Shippensburg Borough Recycling Facility.
