**VISITOR REMARKS**

Franklin Way - Mr. Bobby Kendall thanked the supervisors for working with Grove Farm Development to get Franklin Way paved.

Mr. Garrick Eby brought a photo of the Township property on White Church Road that adjoins his property. He stated there are about 8-10 Ash trees on the Township property that have died and could fall onto his property damaging his barn or vehicles. He feels Township would be liable for these trees.

Mr. Eby would like the Township to be proactive and remove the trees prior to them falling. He presented the Township with an estimate to have the trees taken down.

Supervisor Richardson stated that the problem is the Township's responsibility and he is in favor of removing the trees.

Supervisor Witter stated he knew of several individuals who would remove the trees for free if Mr. Eby could wait until winter when the ground is frozen and leaves are off the trees.

Mr. Eby replied that would be acceptable. He is willing to permit whoever is taking the trees down to access from his side of the property.

Supervisor Richardson asked that Mr. Eby paint the trees that are to be taken down.
