## **SUBDIVISIONS**

### Naugle Bond Reduction

Mr. Kirk Naugle paved the roads for Briary Ridge. He is requesting a bond reduction for the road portion of the bond.

In his e-mail of October 7<sup>th</sup>, Tim Cormany recommended releasing no more than 50% (\$28,481.75) of the road bonding until ancillary stormwater/grading issues are addressed, and as-built is provided to verify proper width and grades.

MOTION: Supervisor Brenize moved to reduce the security required for Briary Ridge by \$28,481.75. Supervisor Cressler seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

## **REPORTS OF TOWNSHIP OFFICIALS AND AGENCIES**

Supervisor Brenize reported that he is getting quotes from both Commonwealth Code Inspection Agency and PA Municipal Code for performing rental inspections for the Township.
