SUBDIVISION AND LAND DEVELOPMENT

SD2021-009 Volvo Customer Center

Hillary Dunning presented the Volvo Customer Center plan to the commission explaining the original plan included a larger building than was previously built. This 23,000 s.f. addition is still within the original approved plan. The stormwater infiltration basin was installed to meet the demands of the full build-out so it is sufficient as built.

Volvo has analyzed their parking needs and the existing parking will be adequate on a daily basis, but there may be training days when a shuttle needs to bring employees from the excess parking on the main Volvo campus.

Chairman Benhart reviewed the comments from Tim Cormany's letter dated HRG stated October 6, 2021.

Maria stated that most comments are standard outside agency approvals.

Scott and Hillary added that all of the comments can easily be addressed including the design comment. Financial security should not be much because the stormwater is already in place. Typically, that is determined once the changes have all been made.

MOTION: Maria Misner moved to approve the final land development plan for Volvo

provided all of the outstanding comments are satisfied and financial security is secured. Dave Rohr seconded the motion which passed

unanimously.
