## **OLD BUSINESS**

Fire Department ARPA Funding

The Township desired to make a one-time transfer of ARPA funds to help mitigate financial hardships incurred by the Township Fire Departments due to COVID-19. Solicitor Kelso prepared a document for each West End Fire and Rescue and Pleasant Hall based upon documentation of expenditures.

MOTION: Supervisor Brenize moved to contribute \$118,983.00 to

WEFR and \$3,869.00 to Pleasant Hall based upon

documentation each provided. Supervisor Cressler seconded

the motion which passed unanimously.

# White Church Road Cattle Crossing

The Township received a letter asked for some sort of help due to vehicles driving into cattle while crossing the road approximately twice a month.

Solicitor Kelso said she has researched this. PennDOT does not recommend anything unless there is a sight distance problem which there is not in this case.

Supervisor Cressler asked Solicitor Kelso if the Township could donate some old saw horses with flashing lights. A letter would accompany saying they were a donation. The Township would not be held liable.

Ordinance 21-005 - Mayapple/Mapleton Speed Limit & Stop / Sign Ordinance Solicitor Kelso stated both Ordinances have been advertised and are ready for adoption. This ordinance places stop signs on Mayapple Drive between Mapleton Road to the dead end, and on Mapleton Road between Orrstown Road to the dead end as the speed study recommended.

Supervisor Hall seconded the motion which passed

unanimously.

Ordinance 21-006 - Spring Ridge Road Speed Limit Ordinance

The speed study recommended a speed limit of 35 mph on Spring Ridge Road between Orrstown Road and Roxbury Road.

Brenize seconded the motion which passed unanimously.
