Reconstructive Planning Form Approval for Leland Diehl

Vince Elbel, Sewer Enforcement Officer, is asking for reconstructive planning form for Leland Diehl's lot. When Leland's subdivision was approved, they should have gotten a DEP approval letter. They were unable to locate one. As long as the subdivision was recorded before 1987, which this one was, DEP gives the authority to go ahead and issue a permit without it.

MOTION: Supervisor Cressler moved to approve the Reconstructive Planning Form per the Sewer Enforcement Officer's recommendation. Supervisor Brenize seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

REPORTS OF TOWNSHIP OFFICIALS AND AGENCIES

Code Enforcement Officer's Report – Mr. Jamie White reported that there is a property on Lindsay Lot Road that has high weeds. He sent the first certified letter and is now ready to send the second one giving the resident ten additional days to respond. Secretary/Treasurer's Report – Mrs. Kathy Durf reported that she has reached out to PSATS to schedule Flagger Training for Township Employees on October 5th, 2022.
